ACT 1

INT. WINDGATE MENTAL HOSPITAL, OHIO - SUMMER 1979

DAVE WAGNER, age 29, IS RECEIVING THE LAST OF MULTIPLE ELECTROCONVULSIVE THERAPY (ECT) (aka electro shock therapy) sessions at the Windgate mental hospital in Ohio. DAVE has been a musician/french hornist in The Cleveland Orchestra since 1972 at the age of 22.

But the "business" of professional music has destroyed his love of music as a creative art, and DAVE HAS SUFFERED A NERVOUS BREAKDOWN AND CLINICAL DEPRESSION. As DAVE drifts into sub-consciousness during the ECT treatment he vows that he will go to Minnesota to live on 80 acres he owns in the country and build a house, and a new life.

EXT. DAVE WAGNER WALKING A ROAD - MINNESOTA - AUTUMN 1980

The song Minnesota Winds begins.

We see DAVE WAGNER, now age 30, walking a 1/2 Mile gravel road leading to his 80 acres of land in Minnesota. MAPLE, OAK AND BIRCH TREES LINE THE ROAD AND ARE IN BEAUTIFUL COLORS OF FALL FOLIAGE. The road dead-ends into a 10 acre field where a small cabin sits that Dave has built.

DAVE WALKS OUT INTO THE FIELD, RUNNING HIS HANDS OVER THE TALL CLOVER as he sings the opening song to the play.

Dave stands alone in the open field, his face to the wind as the song and wind sounds fade.

FADE OUT

EXT. DAVE ON ROOF OF HIS HOUSE

The scene opens with DAVE WAGNER on the roof of his newly built house. He is pounding in shingles with a hammer.

ARNIE TORGENSEN, age 42, comes driving up to welcome Dave and invite him to attend Arnie's church.

Arnie climbs up on the roof and helps Dave hammer on shingles as they talk about how Dave got to Minnesota, his divorce, the nervous breakdown, etc.

Arnie yells up to Dave on his roof.

Hello there!

DAVE

Hello back!

ARNIE

I'm Arnie Torgenson from Plains just south of here. I heard you had moved up here and wanted to come welcome you.

Dave climbs down a ladder and shakes Arnie's hand.

DAVE

Great to meet you Arnie!

Dave pulls out a couple of lawn chairs for Arnie and him to sit down and talk

DAVE (CONT'D) So Arnie, what do you do for a living?

ARNIE I sell custom office furniture to businesses, stores and the like.

DAVE

That sounds cool. Hopefully business is good - I suppose you travel around the state?

ARNIE

Yah sure..,lots of travel but always home for weekends with my family.

DAVE And your family..? wife, kids?

ARNIE My wife is Kate,..she is organist at our church. I have 2 kids, Paul is 17 and Rhonda is 16.

Dave is interested in Arnie's church.

DAVE So your wife is an organist,..at which church?

ARNIE

Faith Methodist Church in Plains. It's a small congregation,..about 120 members I think right now? Are you looking for a church to attend?

DAVE

Yes sir!

ARNIE We would love to have you come next Sunday! Service is at 10:00 am.

DAVE Great! I will plan to be there!

ARNIE

So,..Dave,..looks like you still have some shingling to do yet! Can I give you a hand? I've done my share of carpentry,..

Dave welcomes Arnie's offer with enthusiasm.

DAVE

Oh my gosh,..yes!! I have an extra hammer ready and waiting!

Dave and Arnie climb up on the roof preparing to pound shingles. Arnie stands a moment admiring the view of Dave's land from his roof.

ARNIE

Wow, what a beautiful view from up here! So Dave, how did you end up here in Minnesota?

Dave is cautious.

DAVE

Well, I actually used to be a musician. I played in The Cleveland Orchestra in Ohio.

ARNIE

Wow,...I Have heard of it! It is a world-class orchestra! You must be pretty damn good? Why did you leave?

DAVE

Well, honestly I just burned out of the business of professional music,..just not creative! So I came here to try living a simpler life in Minnesota.

ARNIE

Why Minnesota? You know it gets pretty cold here,..

Dave interrupts Arnie,..

DAVE I was married for 7 years. At that time my wife's brother and his family lived just East of here. We came up to visit and I fell in love with the area.

ARNIE Oh, so you are divorced? Must have been a tough time there also?

Dave turns noticeably morose, ..

DAVE She left me when I told her I wanted to move here.

ARNIE Well, crap Dave! Maybe we can find a nice Minnesota gal for you?

DAVE Yeah maybe,..not looking right now though.

ARNIE

Got ya!

DAVE Thanks,..things a lot better here now. I needed a new place, a new home,..

CHOREOGRAPHY:

DAVE AND ARNIE ON ROOF OF DAVE'S HOUSE

Dave and Arnie pound shingles as they sing the song $\underline{I've Come}$.

The cowbell and wood block sounds in the song mimic hammers.

Dave and Arnie dance to the rhythm of the song - flipping hammers, nails and shingles to each other,..albeit Dave and Arnie are very careful dancing NOT to fall off the roof! Music plays. Dave and Arnie sing. SONG 2: I'VE COME HOME (3:31) http://www.pugetsoundmusical.com/minnesota/ivecomehome.mp3 DAVE (CONT'D) [verse 1] I've got a place, where I can go, Know I'm gonna find, some peace of mind, Livin' here alone. [verse 2] There was a time, when I was sad, Now that I am here, haven't shed a tear, Things aren't so bad! DAVE & ARNIE [chorus] I've come home! I've come home! [bass guitar solo - 8 bars] [verse 3] Love wasn't mine, when I was sure, I fell apart, with a broken heart, There was no cure! [verse 4] I realized, where I went wrong, Listened to the word, I was finally heard, faith made me strong! DAVE & ARNIE (CONT'D) [chorus] I've come home! I've come home! (oh lord!)

[bass guitar solo - 24 bars]
DAVE & ARNIE (CONT'D)

[bass guitar solo tag - end]

As the song, (and scene) ends, the shingling done, Dave and Arnie laugh, shake hands and break out a couple of beers sitting on the roof, watching the sun set.

INT. FAITH METHODIST CHURCH

It is a few weeks later as Dave enters the Faith Methodist Church in Plains, Minnesota. There are a number of greeters as Dave walks in.

Arnie is a greeter and approaches Dave to introduce him to his family.

ARNIE Hey Dave! You made it - great to see you again!

Arnie motions to his wife KATE and their two children to come meet Dave.

ARNIE (CONT'D) (to Kate) Kate,..this is Dave - the fellow I hammered shingles with last week. (to Dave) Dave,..this is my wife Kate.

KATE (condescending) Hello Dave,..very nice to meet you. So very nice of you to come to our church today. (MORE) KATE (CONT'D) I'm the church organist and music director.

Dave senses Kate's attitude of superiority towards him. Nevertheless he is gracious to Kate.

DAVE Very nice to meet you Kate...

Arnie introduces Dave to his two children.

ARNIE Dave this is my son Paul,..and our youngest,..my lovely daughter Rhonda.

Dave shakes Paul's hand then as he moves to shake Rhonda's hand he is taken aback by her natural beauty, albeit she is only 16.

DAVE Hi Paul nice to meet you,..and,..uhh,..Rhonda,..

As 16-year old Rhonda shakes Dave's hand she is noticeably infatuated with 30-year old Dave.

RHONDA Hi Dave,.. you are really handsome!

Arnie quickly leads Dave away from Rhonda's come-on.

ARNIE Come with me Dave, let me introduce you to our pastor, Reverend VanCotter.

Arnie leads Dave up to the lectern where Reverend Manford Vancotter is talking with some parishioners.

ARNIE(CONT) (CONT'D) Reverend VanCotter I'd like to introduce you to a new person in the area,..Dave Wagner.

REVEREND VANCOTTER Nice to meet you Dave,..welcome to our little church!

Reverend Vancotter and Dave shake hands and start to chat.

DAVE

Thank you reverend! Lovely church,..and so intimate out here in the country.

REVEREND VANCOTTER

Please call me Van - everyone else does! So, Dave, I think Arnie told me you are quite the musician? and, Arnie said you write your own songs?

DAVE

Yes that's right Van. Most are set to guitar and singing. But just last week I finished a new song that includes organ and a church choir!

REVEREND VANCOTTER

How cool!! So, do you have your guitar with you today? It turns out we don't have any special music for today's service! If the song is not too hard we could run it by the choir, and of course Kate as church organist, and you could perform it!

DAVE

Uhhh,..yeah I guess we could give it a try - simple chords and the choir sings mostly ooh-ahhs,..

REVEREND VANCOTTER Let's get Kate and the folks together! We have 45 minutes before the service starts,..go for it Dave!

There is now a flurry of activity as Dave rushes out to his car to get his guitar.

Dave comes back in and starts explaining the song, <u>You Gotta</u> <u>Have Faith</u> to Kate and the 10 members of the choir. They all start humming as a way to learning Dave's song as many more church members file in the door to the church.

Finally, after a few more minutes the choir takes it's place at the front of the church. Reverend VanCotter welcomes all and announces the opening hymn: "Onward Christian Soldiers". The entire throng sings the hymn loudly. As the hymn ends Reverend VanCotter steps up to announces Dave's song.

REVEREND VANCOTTER (CONT'D) Everyone, ... we have a new resident in the area as a visitor to our church today. This is his first visit but we are hoping he will become a member! Please welcome Mr. Dave Wagner, .. [applause] As a coincidence we did not have a special song for today's service,...but Dave, it turns out, is a professional musician! He has just completed a new song and with some quick rehearsing with the choir and Kate we are ready to have Dave perform his song You Gotta Have Faith. Take it away Dave!!

As the song ends Reverand VanCotter and the church parishioners rush onto the stage shaking hands, giving congratulations and hugs for Dave and the choir.

FADE IN:

INT. REVEREND VANCOTTER'S OFFICE - FAITH METHODIST CHURCH

Reverend VanCotter's office at the Faith Methodist Church. Dave is meeting with with Reverand VanCotter about Dave's search for love.

REVEREND VANCOTTER (to Dave) So Dave, tell me more about yourself. Arnie has told me some things.

DAVE Well I'm a former musician with The Cleveland Orchestra,..classical music,..

REVEREND VANCOTTER Wow! Hey Dave,..that Is one fine orchestra! I have lots of recordings of Szell and Cleveland!

DAVE I started with Cleveland 2 years after Szell's death. My music director was Lorin Maazel.

REVEREND VANCOTTER (smiling) Well, still Szell's orchestra though, right?

DAVE Absolutely!

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REVEREND VANCOTTER So tell me Dave, how can I help?

DAVE

I'm happy in my new life here in Minnesota. Building the house is keeping me busy. But I am having a faith crisis,..and I need a woman,..

REVEREND VANCOTTER (compassionately) Yes, I can imagine. You're divorced, right?

DAVE

Yes. It was a 7 year marriage that only lasted 5 years.

REVEREND VANCOTTER

What happened, if I may ask?

DAVE

I had a nervous breakdown, and clinical depression,..the orchestra was over-the-top stress 24-7! I wasn't prepared for it. So as I came out of the depression I realized I had to make a lifechange.

REVEREND VANCOTTER So you decided on Minnesota,..how did you 'discover' us? (big smile)

DAVE

(thoughtful)

Ironically it was a visit to my (now) ex-wife's brother and his family who had moved here 3 years before. We spent a week with them on their farm. I was awe-struck by the simplicity of Minnesota farm living,..I thought my wife felt the same,..six months later she and I bought the 80 acres I'm living on now.

REVEREND VANCOTTER But ultimately,..your wife didn't want the change?

DAVE

(sadness,..crying) No sir! She left one day and disappeared! Never saw her again until the divorce.

REVEREND VANCOTTER

Wow, definitely a tough one Dave! But not unusual as I am sure you know.

DAVE

So, yeah. Once the divorce was final my ex-wife signed over the land to me. I quit the orchestra and headed straight here!

REVEREND VANCOTTER

(with enthusiasm) So now we need to find you a Minnesota girl! Maybe find a new job..? But very important we, should I say, re-discover your faith?

DAVE

Yeah,...I thought I knew what faith was,...you know, believing in god?

REVEREND VANCOTTER ,...but,...you don't do you?

DAVE

(negatively) What?,..believe in god?..no sir! But,..I do believe in Jesus,..and the miracles he performed,..and I believe that we can still experience Jesus miracles in our lives!

REVEREND VANCOTTER

Ah yes,..in your song? "You gotta have faith in Jesus miracles,.."

DAVE

(excited)

Exactly! I believe it is a Jesus miracle that I survived a total mental collapse,..and it is a Jesus miracle that I am sitting here in Minnesota right now talking to you!

REVEREND VANCOTTER

I can understand what you are saying Dave. So, why don't you and I start a weekly get-together. Say, an hour set aside each week so we can work together on your faith issues,..(smiling)and of course women! You need to get involved in the community,..maybe get a job,..

DAVE

Yes Van! I just applied yesterday for a job as reporter with the local county paper, The Ashland County Weekly! REVEREND VANCOTTER Yes Dave! That's the ticket! You will surely meet eligible ladies as you work on different stories!

DAVE And also part of the job is covering local county board meetings.

REVEREND VANCOTTER Hope you get the job Dave! It sounds perfect for meeting new people!

DAVE Yah sure,.. (giggling at his new Minnesota accent) Trouble is,..I'm pretty shy with women. All of my former girlfriends, including my wife were french horn players like me! Sure limits the choices up here!

REVEREND VANCOTTER (with a twinkle in his eye) You know Dave,..as men we need the proper 'tools' to connect with women,..look in her eyes,..and use your musical talents to communicate,..

Amazingly Van goes to a closet in his office and pulls out 2 guitar cases! He opens one case to reveal a Gibson SG electric guitar!

DAVE (very surprised) Holy cow Van...you were a rocker!?

REVEREND VANCOTTER (a wry smile) Yessir Dave! Had my own band,..we played mostly blues rock,..

Van goes opens the other guitar case to reveal a 1965 Fender Stratocaster electric guitar. He hands it to Dave.

REVEREND VANCOTTER (CONT'D) Come on Dave,..let's jam! As a driving drum beat starts Dave grabs the Fender Strat and follows Van out to the church sanctuary. They rock out to the song <u>Windows Of The Soul</u> trading crunch guitar solos.

The song Windows Of The Soul begins.

Reverend VanCotter and Dave sing.

SONG 4: WINDOWS OF THE SOUL (6:42)

DAVE [verse 1] Searchin' for love, Tryin' to describe, All of my feelin's,..deep inside! REVEREND VANCOTTER

Here's my advice, Look in her eyes, Let her see Dave,..true and tried.

[chorus 1]

REVEREND VANCOTTER (CONT'D) Paint her a picture, my dear friend, Share a few secrets, no one knows, Look in your own eyes, and see, Thru the windows,...of the soul.

REVEREND VANCOTTER (CONT'D) (spoken) You see Dave,..with women you need to sense their rhythm!

DAVE (spoken) Yeah baby,..rock 'n roll!

DAVE (CONT'D) [verse 2] Follow the road, stay on the line, Keep to the beat, sense the time.

REVEREND VANCOTTER

It's happen' now, You're gonna win, All of your love, is sinkin' in.

REVEREND VANCOTTER (CONT'D) [chorus 2] Paint her a picture, DAVE I see it now! REVEREND VANCOTTER (wry smile) Share a few secrets, no one knows, DAVE (acknowledging) Look in my own eyes, and see, Thru the windows, ... of the soul. REVEREND VANCOTTER AND DAVE (Van and Dave nod to each other) Thru the windows, ... of the soul. GUITAR SOLOS (32 bars) - crunch chords REVEREND VANCOTTER (spoken) I think you have it now Dave! DAVE [verse 3] Hang onto my dreams, I'm never too old, Succeeding at love, I gotta be bold! REVEREND VANCOTTER When you stare in the mirror, don't be afraid! You can never return, to yesterday! REVEREND VANCOTTER (CONT'D) [chorus 3] Paint her a picture, DAVE I've got it! REVEREND VANCOTTER (wry smile) Share a few secrets, ... no one knows!

DAVE (acknowledging) Look in my own eyes, and see, Thru the windows, ... of the soul. REVEREND VANCOTTER AND DAVE [chorus 4 final] Paint her a picture, DAVE It's clear now! REVEREND VANCOTTER (wry smile) Share a few secrets, DAVE (shout) ,.. no one knows! DAVE (CONT'D)

(acknowledging) Look in my own eyes, and see, Thru the windows,..of the soul.

REVEREND VANCOTTER AND DAVE (Van and Dave nod to each other and shake hands) Thru the windows,..of the soul.

GUITAR SOLOS (56 bars + 8 slowing to END) - crunch chords

Dave and Reverend VanCotter rock-out trading guitar chord crunch solos. As song ends Dave and Reverend VanCotter hug each other, laughing as they walk out of the church.

INT. DAVE & YOUTH GROUP GO ROLLER-SKATING - WINTER 1980-81

Two weeks later. Dave has volunteered to take the Faith Methodist Church Youth Group to a local roller-skating rink. Dave has established a close friendship with 18-yr old WARREN HOWARD, son of a dairy farmer from the church.

Two 16 year old girls from the youth group, Rhonda (Arnie's daughter) and her best friend LAURA are already competing with each other for the affections of 30-years old Dave! Dave and Warren are skating around the rink together talking.

WARREN

Hey Dave - this was a great idea to take the youth group for a rollerskating outing! This rink in Ashland is one of the nicest in the state!

DAVE

Thanks Warren! It sure helps having you along as the oldest of the group to help keep the "kids" in control,..

Rhonda and Laura come skating up to Dave and Warren.

RHONDA Hi Dave! Will you be my partner for the first doubles skate?

LAURA No Dave! You have to be my partner for the first doubles!

Rhonda challenges Laura and pushes her back away from Dave.

RHONDA Laura, leave Dave alone,..he wants to skate with me!

LAURA

Oh Rhonda,..you are so full of it! Tell her Dave,..you want to skate with me, right?

Dave is taken aback by the two 16-year old girls fighting over him. He motions to Warren to come help!

Warren comes skating up quickly,..

DAVE

Laura,..why don't you skate with Warren on the first partners skate? I'll skate with Rhonda on this one then you and I can skate together later, okay?

Laura is obviously hurt but goes off with Warren to skate. Now Dave and Rhonda hold hands and skate together.

> RHONDA Oh gosh, Dave,..you are such a good skater.

Rhonda is blushing as she looks into Dave's eyes and shows her affection.

DAVE Thanks Rhonda,..you skate really well also!

Rhonda and Dave skate together not saying much. Rhonda keeps looking at Dave,..holding his hand tighter as they skate.

Laura leaves off with Warren then joins the other girls from the youth group as they skate together.

The "Youth Group Girls" start a chant as they skate right behind Rhonda and Dave. Then all break into the song <u>Rhonda</u>.

RHONDA

[verse 1]

Blood pumpin' thru my heart Dave, I want you in my life, I saw your face, in all my dreams last night. Three-o'clock in the mornin', I feel so much in love, It's in the hands, of our faithful spirt above!

YOUTH GROUP GIRLS

[chorus] Rho-onda,..Rho-onda,..Rho-onda,.. You wanna be Dave's girl!

RHONDA

[verse 2] You know our love is confusin', But who can say that it's wrong, Two people together,..can make somethin' simple so strong. Ain't no use in denyin', All the feelin's we share, We've fallen in love and now we're a matching pair! YOUTH GROUP GIRLS [chorus] Rho-o-onda,..Rho-o-onda,...You wanna be Dave's girl!

[French horn solo]

RHONDA

[verse 3]
Now I'm getting' a notion, tell me if you agree,
We can share our thoughts, but only you and me.
Oh, it isn't much longer,
,..then we can sing to the world,
The special love between Dave and his special girl!

YOUTH GROUP GIRLS

[chorus 2x] Rho-o-onda,..Rho-o-onda,..Rho-o-onda,.. You wanna be Dave's girl!

Rhonda leaves Dave and joins the girls as they all sing the final chorus.

RHONDA & YOUTH GROUP GIRLS

[chorus 2x]
Rho-o-onda,..Rho-o-onda,..Rho-o-onda,..
You wanna be Dave's girl!

RHONDA

I wanna be Dave's girl!

The girls all continue to skate as a group as Rhonda and Laura continue pushing each other around.

FADE OUT:

CUT TO:

INT. DAVE BACK AT HIS HOUSE WITH WARREN

Dave and Warren drive back to Dave's house. They are sharing a couple of beers and talking about Rhonda and Laura,..

DAVE I mean shit, Warren,..Rhonda and Laura were almost ready to physically fight over me? WARREN Yeah,..you have them wrapped around your fingers! Too bad they're only 16!

DAVE Rhonda is only 16? Oh my gosh,..she seems older maybe 18,..I was hoping she was 18,..

WARREN Nope, she's only 16,..hold on Dave,..you're thinking way too much about her aren't you?

DAVE Yeah,..I am,..

WARREN

There is no way you could have anything with Rhonda! She is underage!

Dave starts walking in circles. He is confused with his feelings for Rhonda.

DAVE

You know Warren, it's like I'm livin' in some kind of time machine. When I had 16 year old girlfriends back in high school. You know they were that young!

WARREN

Yeah, Dave, that's what I'm tryin' to tell you,..you think too much! This ain't high school for you anymore. You're 30 and she's 16,..it ain't gonna work!

The song Time Machine begins.

SONG 6: TIME MACHINE (5:10)

DAVE

[verse 1] Tonite was such a strange re-al-ity!, Those 2 girls were fighting over me, Both of them just turning age 16,.. A crazy dream!

WARREN You can say that again! WARREN (CONT'D) [verse 2] They're both growing up in such a rush! DAVE gotta slow then down! WARREN An older guy like you just makes them blush, DAVE So what do I do? WARREN Let it go, can't do no harm it's just a crush! DAVE AND WARREN [chorus] Livin' in a time machine, Tryin' to remember the history, Recallin' the love at age 16, Livin' in a time, ... machine! [solo horn & strings] DAVE [verse 3] Rhonda says she wants to be my girl, WARREN I don't think that'll work,... DAVE How do I respond and not hurt her?, WARREN She'll be just fine,.. DAVE It might be true she has hold of my heart, but that's absurd!

WARREN

Yeah boy, yeah boy,..

WARREN (CONT'D)

[verse 4]

You think too much she's not the one right now!

DAVE

...obviously..

WARREN

There's other girls your age that can be found,

DAVE

...legally,..

WARREN Common sense should guide your heart to safer ground!

DAVE AND WARREN

[chorus] Livin; in a time machine, Tryin' to remember the history, Recallin' the love at age 16, Livin' in a time,...machine!

[solo horn]

DAVE AND WARREN (CONT'D) [chorus - final] Livin' in a time machine, Tryin' to remember the history, Recallin' the love at age 16,

Livin' in a time machine! Livin' in a time machine! Livin' in a time.....machine!

[solo horn & strings to the end]

As the song ends Dave and Warren sit outside talking, laughing, and drinking some beers thru the night.

FADE OUT:

INT. ARNIE'S HOUSE - RHONDA'S BASEMENT BEDROOM

Rhonda is her basement bedroom talking to her stuffed bunny she has named "Dave". Rhonda is talking to her bunny about the real DAVE and how much she has fallen in love with him. Rhonda does not realize that her dad Arnie has come part-way down the stairs and is listening to her.

RHONDA

Well bunny Dave, (hugging the bunny),...I have fallen in love with Dave!

DAVE THE BUNNY (VOICED BY RHONDA) Oh yes, Rhonda! I can see you are in love!

RHONDA

But I am still only 16,..and Dave is quite a bit older than me,..a 30year old man,..is he too old for me!

Arnie now clears his throat and comes the rest of the way down stairs to Rhonda's bedroom.

ARNIE

Sorry to eavesdrop,..heard your conversation with Dave the bunny,..honey, the human Dave is too old for you,..I mean he is 14 years older than you,..and you, my darling daughter are not of a "legal" age to have a relationship with a 30 year old man,..

RHONDA

Dad, you have always commented how I have an "old soul",..only 16 physically but inside I feel like a woman! I relate better to older people than kids and boys my own age,.. ARNIE sits down next to Rhonda and hugs her.

ARNIE

Yes honey I have said that about you. You are very mature for only 16, intelligent and so beautiful,..but you are still legally only 16 years old,..and if an older man like Dave had a relationship with you he could go to jail! It's called statutory rape because you are considered a minor still at 16,..

RHONDA

I guess I understand,.. I have heard of statutory rape.

ARNIE

So, yes honey,..you will just have to wait a couple more years,..then see if you and Dave,..

RHONDA

(interrupting Arnie) But Dad,..Mom would never approve of Dave! She is so jealous of him as a musician! She is always dumping on him about something,..

ARNIE

Yeah I know,..she can be really petty sometimes. So, it might be more years to wait for Dave until you are in your 20's and an adult and on your own.

RHONDA

So,...how many more years is that?

ARNIE

I suppose maybe 4, 5,..why don't we arbitrarily say 6 years from now,..?

Arnie and Rhonda sing Six years From Now.

SONG 7: SIX YEARS FROM NOW (3:12)

ARNIE (CONT'D) You're feelin' somethin' Deep in your heart, I can't say it's really wrong, But maybe it ain't smart? It might be true, that time really flies, And love will stick around,..? But, Rhonda will you still love him? Six years from now?

RHONDA

Lots of rules to follow, But he's oh, so sweet!, (Dave The Bunny: Yeah he's so ve-ry sweet!) I try so hard to avoid his smile, But I can't resist he knocks me off my feet! Can't set the hands of time ahead, So I'll be patient just for now, Daddy will I still love him?

RHONDA & ARNIE Six years from now!..hoo!

[string pizzacato with celeste]

ARNIE ("My darling daughter!") Get a grip he'll be thirty-six!

RHONDA

But I'll still want to love him!, (Dave The Bunny: And you can count on that!)

RHONDA (CONT'D)

You can call me crazy,

Rest assured I've made my pick! (Dave The Bunny: She's made her pick!)

He's gonna be six times more special, In Nine-teen-eighty-six!

ARNIE

Maybe you could just hold hands,..? But I doubt that it would be allowed? Rhonda, will you still love him? Six years from now? RHONDA

Daddy yes I know I'll still love him!

ARNIE

Six years?

RHONDA & ARNIE

Six year-ear-ears! Fro-o-o-om,..now!!

RHONDA (hugging Arnie) I love you Daddy!

ARNIE (hugging Rhonda back) I love you too honey,..

Arnie and Rhonda hug each other, crying and laughing together as the song ends.

FADE OUT

FADE IN:

INT. FAITH METHODIST CHURCH

Faith Methodist Church service is in session. Rhonda has written a love note to Dave. As Reverend VanCotter starts the sermon, Rhonda passes her note to Dave who is sitting three rows ahead - but as the note is passing, Rhonda's mother, Kate, intercepts it. Kate reads it and immediately gets up and grabs Rhonda and drags her out of the church sanctuary into the narthex.

> RHONDA Mom,..you're hurting me,..

KATE You're damn right I'm hurting you! Are you crazy? Writing a love note to a man almost twice your age?

RHONDA But I love him Mom! I know I do,..and I'm sure he loves me too! KATE

Has he said that to you? Did he say he loves you?

RHONDA Well,..no,..I can just tell he does.

Arnie now comes out of the sanctuary.

ARNIE Kate, what is going on?

KATE Arnie, your daughter wrote this love note and was passing it up to Dave!

ARNIE (Arnie reads the note then looks at Rhonda) Honey,..we talked about this the other night,..

KATE

(furious with Arnie) You talked about this with her?,.and never told me about it? Arnie, you are such a spineless father! Must I be the only parent who practices any serious discipline?

Kate slaps Arnie in the face. Then she slaps Rhonda as well.

KATE (CONT'D) So,..this is going to stop right now! I'm going to Reverend Van and tell him to throw Dave out of our church! Then I'm going to take Dave aside and tell him to keep away from my daughter!

Kate grabs Rhonda's arm and drags her outside. Arnie follows and pleads with Kate.

ARNIE Now listen Kate,..you let me talk to Dave. I am sure he did not have any idea Rhonda would write such a note! The best thing for you to do is take Rhonda home. (MORE)

ARNIE (CONT'D)

I'll bring the other kids home after church then I will drive up to Dave's house and talk to him.

KATE (hesitant) Alright,.. but you tell that bastard Dave to stay away from Rhonda, or I'll have him arrested!

Kate drags Rhonda to their car and drives away. Arnie paces around the parking lot as he sings the song <u>Spiteful Wife</u>.

SONG 8: SPITEFUL WIFE (5:47)

[Horn solo begins the song]

ARNIE

[verse 1]
Kate is so damn hard, I want to scream out loud,

EXT. ARNIE VISITS DAVE AT HIS HOUSE

Arnie drives up to Dave's house. Dave comes outside to welcome Arnie into his house. Arnie is visibly upset about the love note Rhonda tried to pass to Dave in church.

> DAVE Hey Arnie! Wow, didn't I just see you in church? Come on in,..

Dave is sensing Arnie is very serious about something as he does not want to come into the house.

DAVE (CONT'D) What is it Arnie? What's wrong?

Arnie produces Rhonda's note and shows it to Dave. Dave reads the note.

DAVE (CONT'D) Wow! I guess I knew Rhonda was enamored with me. (MORE) DAVE (CONT'D) I had overheard her talking to her friends at the roller-skating party,..but I had no idea she would write something like this to me,..

ARNIE

Yeah, it's pretty graphic for my sweet 16-year old daughter.

Dave gives a "what do we do now?" look to his friend Arnie.

DAVE

I'm not sure what to do..?

ARNIE

I'll talk to her of course. But there is a bigger problem. Kate is furious - she is the one who intercepted the note. She thinks you might have had relations with Rhonda,..

DAVE

Oh my gosh no! No way! I care for Rhonda very much but she is absolutely, way too young!

ARNIE

(Understandingly but direct and concerned)

Yeah,..Rhonda and I had a long talk about you last week. I was sure she had accepted the fact that right now she is too young for you. I did tell her maybe in a few years when she is 22,..maybe you too could re-connect. But for now,..with this incident,..Dave, I have to ask you to not have any more contact with Rhonda.

DAVE

Yes Arnie!,...you're right,...of course!..but the youth group,..the other kids will want to know why.

ARNIE

Dave, I am so sorry! Maybe if I had been more forceful with Rhonda. But I think you will have to give up the youth group, and ultimately,..our church,..otherwise my wife may cause bigger problems for you. Dave is very distraught and he begins to cry.

DAVE Yeah, it's time for me to think about moving on.

Arnie goes to his car,..turns back to shake Dave's hand.

ARNIE Thanks, Dave,..thanks for all your music and involvement in the church with the kids.

Arnie starts to tear, then gets in his car and drives away up the road. Dave walks back toward his house,..then he stops, standing for the longest time in the drive,..

> DAVE (to himself) What the hell happened? A 16-yr old girl gets a crush on me and writes a love letter to me,..now What do I do? Thanks to her crazy mom I am an outcast from the church,..and I just lost my best friend!!

INT. DAVE SINGS "HIDIN' FROM THE SUN"

Dave finally goes inside and starts going thru the house closing all the curtains making the house very dark and gloomy. He walks over to his piano and begins the song Hidin' From The Sun.

SONG 9: HIDIN' FROM THE SUN' (5:25)

DAVE (CONT'D) [verse 1] What is life? ,..huh? I gotta know, I sneak around,..wondering why, Just when life,..seems so good, It slips away!

[verse 2]

FADE TO BLACK:

INT./EXT. DAVE LEAVES MINNESOTA - AUTUMN 1981

Dave boxes his belongings inside his house. He has decided to rent out his house and property and travel to the Pacific Northwest to find forestry work.

> DAVE (mumbling to himself as he packs) Ever since I was in my teens I have wanted to work in forestry,..and, I have always wanted to travel to the Pacific Northwest! Guess I need to pray for some Jesus miracles,..it's a long way there,..praying the van will make it,..and that I will be able to get a forestry job with,..duh,..zero experience!

Now Dave walks outside and starts to pack his van with boxes of clothes and belongings. He has a small trailer attached to the van that he also starts loading boxes into. He pauses for a moment to look out over his beautiful field and his house,..his home.

DAVE (CONT'D) God I love this place! (He starts to sob, then shouts) I want to stay! But there's no goddamn women here,..only girls,..it won't work! I gotta get outta here!

Dave continues with packing as he sings Long Way Home

SONG 10: LONG WAY HOME (4:42) http://pugetsoundmusical.com/minnesota/longway2024.mp3

DAVE (CONT'D)

[verse 1]
Does this seem the same, as 3 long years ago?
Packing boxes `til dawn,
Is it adventure, or pursuit of a goal?
Can't really tell, `til you're gone.

[verse 2]

All the children, so loving,
The want of a woman, she is just not here!

ACT 2

EXT. DAVE CAMPING AT COPPER LAKE, WA - SPRING 1982

The scene opens with Dave Wagner at the campground at Copper Lake, Washington, about 25 miles north of Roslyn, Washington.

It is late March

Dave is camping in his 1967 Dodge van. Dave is finishing up cooking some hot dogs over a campfire. It is dead quiet except for the sound of loons out on the lake and their mournful calls.

DAVE Wow! Now, this is why I came to the Pacific Northwest! Look at Mt. Ranier,..still snow on the peak!

Dave starts to walk around the lake shore.

DAVE (CONT'D) (whispering to himself) Wonder if there are any bears around here?

As Dave walks around the lake shore he moves into some heavy brush. All of a sudden there is a loud, throaty grunt!

GRIZZLY BEAR (with a deep grunt) Rummphhhhhh!

Dave stops motionless,..

Dave realizes he has been in a thicket of huckleberry bushes, favorite snacks for grizzly bears! Dave jingles his keys and some light aluminum he has on his belt. He slowly starts backing out as he sings the song <u>Mr. Grizzly</u>.

SONG 11: MR. GRIZZLY (3:58)

DAVE

[verse 1]

INT. DAVE AT CAPITAL FORESTRY COMPANY

The scene opens with Dave Wagner walking into the front office of the Capital Forestry company in Rosyln, Washington. Dave is trying to get a job in forestry.

Seated at the reception desk is a lovely blond woman in her 30's. She is secretary KERRI DETNER.

KERRI Can I help you?

DAVE Hi. My name is Dave Wagner. I would like to apply for work as a forester.

KERRI (very nice smile) Ummmm,..Dave,..okay. Here is an application for you to fill out. You can sit over there. (Kerri motions to some chairs)

DAVE Thanks,..Kerri your nameplate says? Nice to meet you! (Kerri again motions to the chairs)

Dave sits down and begins to fill out the job application. JOHN MASTERS, a man in his 40's walks out of one of the offices. He talks to Kerri.

JOHN Hi Kerri,...have we received any applications for the forestry tech job yet? KERRI (grinning) You won't believe this John! That fellow over there just came in and is filling out an application! JOHN (almost laughing) You're kidding! John walks over to Dave still working on the application. JOHN (CONT'D) (smiling to Dave) Hi there. My name is John Masters. I am the Silviculturist here at Capital! I hear you're looking for a job? DAVE (standing to shake hands with John) Yes sir! My name is Dave Wagner. JOHN Let's sit and talk. (John motions to Dave to sit back down) What kind of forestry experience do you have? DAVE (smiling uncomfortably) None,...but I have a lot of experience living in remote places. The past 3 years I lived on 80 acres in northern Minnesota,..the first year without power or plumbing, ... and I built my own house,...

> JOHN Wow! Let's go to my office and talk some more. (John motions to Kerri) Kerri would you put together a new employee packet? (winking) (MORE)

JOHN (CONT'D) I think Dave is the guy we have been looking for,..

JOHN (CONT'D) (In John's office) Dave, what I need is someone to manage some 100 research installations. My research is in genetic tree improvement and fertilization.

DAVE

(surprised) Wow,..100 installations?

JOHN

Yes actually I think the exact number is 112. What we do is take genetically improved seedlings from our tree nursery and plant them in harvested areas. We measure twice per year to monitor growth potential.

DAVE

(excited) This sounds like really cool work!

JOHN

These research areas are in very remote areas - often a challenge to get to! You would supervise the layout of each installation, the tree plantings and the measurements.

DAVE

(convincingly) John, I can do it!

John sits back in his office chair in thought.

JOHN

(smiling) You know Dave - I agree with you! You're hired as of right now!

DAVE

(determined) John, I won't let you down! Let's get to work.

John goes to the door and calls Kerri into his office. Kerri comes right in.

JOHN

(to Kerri) Kerri I just hired Dave,..get him started on the paperwork.

KERRI (a big smile to Dave) Congratulations Dave! Let's get you to work asap!

FADE OUT

EXT. DAVE IN THE FIELD WITH TREE PLANTERS - LATE SPRING 1982

Dave is now forestry field supervisor for Capital Forestry Company's research group. Dave is standing on a 30 degree slope supervising 2 TREE PLANTERS. There is a light fog mist.

> TREE PLANTER 1 (stopping planting and looking out at the mist) Wow, what a great morning! Look at that cool fog!

DAVE Yeah man,..I Can't believe we're getting paid to do this!

TREE PLANTER 2 (jokingly) We're getting paid?

TREE PLANTER 1 You better believe it!

They continue planting tree seedlings.

All of a sudden Tree Planter 2 stands upright quickly and points down the slope towards their truck parked about 200 yards down on the road below.

TREE PLANTER 2 (excited) Look at that!! Do you see that moose trotting along the road?

Both Dave and Tree Planter 1 also stop to look down at the marvelous sighting.

TREE PLANTER 1 Wow! It's a female,..no rack! She is heading right for the truck! TREE PLANTER 2 No way,..wait,..she just disappeared behind that stand of trees along the road,..

DAVE (looking at the Planters) I guess that's our excitement for this day?

All of a sudden Tree Planter 1 points down the slope.

TREE PLANTER 1 Jesus! There she is,..she's coming right at us!

The moose has started moving fast up the slope from the road. She is heading right for Dave and the planters.

> DAVE (calmly, almost whispering) Okay guys,..freeze! I mean it! Don't make any moves that she might think are agressive!

The song Momma Moose begins.

SONG 12: MOMMA MOOSE (3:10)

Intro: Herb Alpert style trumpets, brass, etc

[verse 1]

DAVE (CONT'D) Moose is coming toward us, from way down below,

Damn it's huge and movin' fast, you sure can't call it slow!

TREE PLANTER 1

Wonder if it's girl or boy, it might mean good or bad?

TREE PLANTER 2 It cannot be a boy moose, it doesn't have a rack! ALL [chorus] It's a momma, momma moose and momma moose are mean! TREE PLANTER 1 (yelling) Gotta run! TREE PLANTER 2 (scared) From that momma! DAVE (controlled) Bad idea!..stay cool...stand your ground! [verse 2] DAVE (CONT'D) Momma moose are dangerous, if she and humans clash! If you take off running, she'll catch you in a flash! TREE PLANTER 1 Make just like a statue and just wait for her to pass! TREE PLANTER 2 Don't look her in the eyes os she might butt you in the ass! AT₁T₁ [chorus 2] It's a momma, momma moose, a momma moose a movin' moose, and it's a momma angry moose, and momma moose are mean! TREE PLANTER 1 (calmer) I won't run! TREE PLANTER 2 I'm a statue!

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DAVE

Now you're thinkin'!....stay cool...stand your ground!

[Herb Alpert style trumpets, brass, etc.]

[verse 3]

DAVE (CONT'D) (as the moose is coming closer)

She'll be here in seconds, stay calm don't come unglued!

She'll be spittin' snot just like a log that's split in two!

TREE PLANTER 1

I'll try to be courageous, and not show her any fear!

TREE PLANTER 2

If she doesn't kill us all I'm buying lots of beer!

ALL

[chorus 3] (less & less whispersinging and STOP! as the moose passes by)

Hello momma, momma moose, you movin' moose and pretty moose, a momma moose, a patient moose, a scootin' moose, not angry moose, oh momma moose just move on momma moose and on your way! STOP!

The moose moves at full gallop as she clears barely 6 feet between Dave and Tree Planter 1. She looks sideways into Dave's eyes as she passes him, then disappears over the top of the ridge.

> TREE PLANTER 1 (gasping) Holy Shit!! TREE PLANTER 2 (stunned)

Did you see that!

DAVE (amazed) She went right between us!

ALL

[chorus final]

What a momma, momma moose, amazing moose, big momma moose, a momma moose, a shaggy moose, a damn BIG moose, a wild moose, oh momma moose just keep on movin' far away from here!

TREE PLANTER 1

Now she's gone!

TREE PLANTER 2 Out of sight now!

DAVE Tell your children!

ALL

We survived!

[ending as beginning]

[Herb Alpert style trumpets, brass, etc.]

TREE PLANTER 2 (yelling) Hey do you guys know where that Herb Alpert mariachi band came from..?

The guys all laugh and shout yahoos.

INT. KERRI GOES TO THE FIELD WITH DAVE - SUMMER 1982

The scene opens with Dave talking with secretary Kerri in the office at Capital Forestry company.

Kerri asks Dave if she can go out to the field (woods) with Dave and help him with tree measurements, etc.

KERRI Hey Dave,..I have never been out in the woods in the 7 years I have worked here! (MORE)

KERRI (CONT'D)

Could you use some help today with measuring, or maybe some other work?

DAVE

Hey that sounds like fun Kerri! But it is kind of rough and tumble work you know, (smiling) I mean if I fall down less than 10 times it is a good day! And, we usually are out 10 hours minimum,..

KERRI Well Dave,..I am a country girl! I was brought up doing farm work. I think I could keep up alright!

DAVE You got a deal Kerri! Can you be ready to head out in 45 minutes?

KERRI I knew you'd say yes! I brought my jeans and field clothes. I'll be ready in 20 minutes!

EXT. DAVE AND KERRI MEASURING TREE SEEDLINGS

The scene opens with Dave and Kerri measuring planted 5 yr old tree seedlings. The 'installation' is on a 10 degree slope with a view of a lovely creek, and Mount Ranier in the background.

> KERRI (as she measures a seedling) Dave,..I get 9.3 inches high,.. (she measure the diameter) ,..and 2.5 centimeters,..?

DAVE (Dave writes down the measurements in a notebook) Got it Kerri! You are a natural at this!

KERRI (sitting back) Wow, this is so much fun! (MORE) KERRI (CONT'D) (looking up at a clear blue sky) And, what a beautiful day!

DAVE (grinning) You know our saying,.."I can't believe I'm getting paid to do this"!

KERRI Hey Dave,..are You ready for lunch?

DAVE Yes indeed - I am hungry!

KERRI Let's go down the hill to the river, ok?

DAVE Sounds good,..I'll race you!

Kerri jumps up and runs down to the truck with Dave close behind. She reaches in and pulls out a couple of sack lunches. Kerri and Dave walk over to the stream and sit down to eat their lunch.

> KERRI This is so nice! What a beautiful day!

DAVE Yeah good timing Kerri,..I was hungry!

KERRI Are you married Dave?

DAVE

Nope. I was married,..didn't work out,..you are married aren't you Kerri?

KERRI Well,..not anymore,..he was a long-

haul truck driver,..gone usually 25 days of the month.

DAVE I guess that was tough to keep things together? KERRI Sure thing. Better now. (now blushing) I've got to be honest Dave,..I am attracted to you,..since that first day you walked into the office.

DAVE Oh my gosh Kerri,..I'm not sure what to say,..

KERRI (changing the subject quickly) Do you run Dave? I like to do a run after lunch,..

DAVE (relieved at the change of subject) Yes Kerri I do run,..got my tennies in the truck. There's a great trail to run,..goes right up the slope of Ranier!

KERRI I brought my running gear also,..let's do it!

Dave and Kerri pack up their lunches and head for the truck. They pull their shoes and clothing out.

> KERRI (CONT'D) It'll just take me a minute to change,..I'll go over to those bushes,.. (with a sweet smile) ,..don't peak!

Kerri comes out from behind the bushes dressed in a halter top and tight short-shorts with tennis shoes.

DAVE (gasping)

Wow!

KERRI (smiling at Dave) I'll lead,..you can take up the rear,..if you can keep up,.. DAVE (laughing) I'll keep up alright! Following you will be a pleasure,..

EXT. DAVE AND KERRI GO FOR A RUN

Kerri and Dave start a run heading towards Mt. Ranier. The song <u>Running Beside Her</u> begins.

Music plays.

SONG 13: RUNNING BESIDE HER (2:40)

DAVE (CONT'D)

[verse 1] Anticipation,..as I wait for her, Wondering if somehow, we could be one? Some new location,..where words couldn't speak Loving each morning, lust in the sun!

KERRI

[verse 2] Equally moving,..striding for stride, Talking so freely, of our former lives, Rounding the corner,..climb up the hill, Now our hearts beating, so much in love!

DAVE

[chorus]
Running beside her!
We're both lost in time,
I can't forget her,

DAVE AND KERRI She's running around in my mi-i-i-ind,

DAVE

[tag 1]
Holding her tightly,..

KERRI AND DAVE Our lips softly meet, DAVE

Running inside her,

KERRI AND DAVE We savor the heat!

KERRI

[verse 1 - recap]
Some new location,

KERRI AND DAVE Where words couldn't speak,

KERRI Loving each morning,..

KERRI AND DAVE Lust on the top of Mount Ranier's pe-ak!

DAVE Holding her tightly,

KERRI AND DAVE Our lips softly meet,

DAVE Running inside her,

KERRI AND DAVE We savor the heat, We savor the heat!

KERRI Running beside him,

DAVE Running inside her,

KERRI Running beside him,

KERRI AND DAVE Running inside,.. [guitar chords syncopation to end] As the song, (and scene) ends, Kerri stops and turns towards Dave as they passionately kiss and embrace. They fall on the ground and make love.

FADE OUT:

INT. DAVE, JOHN AND KERRI GET BAD NEWS

The scene opens with Dave Wagner, John, and Kerri, and other Foresters and staff getting the bad news that Capital Foresty has been sold! The new company wants only to sell off all the timber, so all jobs eliminated!

The CEO addresses about 50 employees.

CEO CAPITAL FORESTRY Ladies and Gentlemen,..I'm afraid the rumors are true. Capital Forestry has been sold,.. (loud groans and crying) The new owners have informed me that all of you are terminated in 30 days.

(louder groans and gasps)
I know, I know,..it Is a hard pill
to swallow for all of us.

JOHN

There goes 20 years of research down the tubes! Goddamn.

KERRI (to Dave and John) I can't believe this! The almighty dollar! (to Dave) Oh my gosh Dave! You've only been here 8 months, and now,..

DAVE

Yeah,...I was sure enjoying working in forestry,..even though I wasn't a full-fledged forester,..

JOHN

(to Dave)

Hold on Dave! In my book you have proven yourself as a terrific field forester! Your organizational skills at managing our field sites have been the best I ever saw! DAVE Thanks John,..it means alot to me,..you have been the best 'boss' I have ever had!

John shakes Dave's hand and gives him a big hug. Then he walks over to Kerri and hugs her also.

JOHN (to Kerri) Well dear Kerri,..thanks so much for keeping me on schedule! (leaving with tears) I need to go to my office for some thought-time,..

KERRI

(to John and Dave) Wait John! Don't be sad, especially by yourself! The three of us need to do something fun! We need to get away from here for a few days!

DAVE (excited to Kerri, then John) Exactly Kerri! You know, ever since I got here we have been working our asses off! I have wanted to see Puget Sound,..let's just disappear from here for the next week and the three of us go to Puget Sound!

John shakes Dave's hand and gives him a big hug. Then he walks over to Kerri and hugs her also.

JOHN (cheering up) Well that's a fantastic idea! (to Kerri) Kerri you have been there alot,..you could connect us with some great seafood and you favorite places in the 'sound'.

KERRI

(to John and Dave) Oh yeah guys! Let's do it! I know a great restaurant right on the 'sound' with the best clam chowder! DAVE Okay,..tomorrow we head to Puget Sound!

JOHN (worried) But tomorrow is Wednesday,..still a work day?

KERRI Screw that!! If they are firing us we can take our leave time now,..tomorrow 8 am we meet right here - and off to Puget Sound!

FADE OUT

FADE IN:

EXT. DAVE, JOHN AND KERRI VISIT PUGET SOUND - AUTUMN 1982

The scene opens with Dave, John, and Kerri taking a last weekend trip together to *Puget Sound*. The scene opens with Dave, John and Kerri walking along a boardwalk, with the skyline of Seattle and Mt. Ranier in the background.

DAVE

(almost out of breath) Wow! This is amazing. I had no idea such a lovely place existed!

JOHN

Yessir,..I've been here probably 2-3 times, but every time I come back I am in awe!

KERRI

I agree with you both! I know what you mean John,..I have been here so many times before. But here today it seems so magical,..with my two best buds!

DAVE

(in deep thought) You know someday, I might like to live here,..(perking up)..but for right now, I have a taste for some clam chowder! KERRI I know just the place Dave,..John have you ever eaten at *Pike Place Chowder?*

JOHN (excited) I don't think so Kerri. Let's take Dave there!

John and Kerri grab Dave's arm and start him down the street. They sit down at the restaurant *Pike Place Chowder*. They order clam chowder.

> KERRI (pointing to a menu) Dave, here it is the on the menu,..Pike's Hefty Clam Chowder!

DAVE 'Hefty' clam chowder? What the hell does that mean?

JOHN (laughing) Probably it's so thick you have to 'heft' one hellava spoon to get it in your mouth?

DAVE Okay,..hefty clam chowder it is! (motioning to a waiter) Give me a bowl of hefty chowder!

KERRI (giggling) You're gonna love it Dave,..trust me!

As Dave is served the clam chowder the song <u>Chowder Heads</u> begins.

[verse 1]

DAVE

Sitting here on Puget Sound at this fine restaurant, John and Kerri my two friends, chowder excellants! I suppose I shouldn't worry as I spoon it from the bowl,

Holy cow! I love this chowder!

KERRI

Told you so!!

[verse 2]

KERRI (CONT'D)

I've been eating chowder at this place for many years,

It just keeps getting better every time I journey here!

JOHN

So, Dave what is your best rating, for this yummy clam-puree?

DAVE It's delicious! Nothing more that I can say!

ALL

[chorus]
We are Puget Sound chowder heads!
We'll eat clam chowder `til we're dead!
So strange it may seem, chowder keeps us fit and
lean!
We'll eat another bowl after bed!

[accordian solo]

[verse 3]

DAVE We could come back here every time that we are working near?

KERRI

Oh what the heck!, why don't we move our offices to here?!

JOHN Won't the bosses be suspicious when we don't show up for work? [STOP!] DAVE Who cares? KERRI We quit! JOHN We're fired! [all 3 slowly in harmony] ALL Those dirty sons-of-a-bitch! So, here we are,.. best friends for the rest of our lives. We'll always be,.. huggers of trees,... [spoken] DAVE Oh my gosh,.. KERRI We've been drinking too much, huggers of trees..? JOHN Yeah, but, shit, ... if we aren't going to be foresters,..then what the hell else is there..? ALL Our profession is now lifetime chowder heads! [chorus 2] ALL (CONT'D) We are Puget Sound chowder heads!

We'll eat clam chowder 'til we're dead!

So strange it may seem, chowder keeps us fit and lean! We'll have another bowl instead of bread!

[chorus 3]

ALL (CONT'D) We are Puget Sound chowder heads! We will eat clam chowder 'til we're dead! [acapella] So strange it may seem,.. chowder keeps us fit and lean,.! We'll eat another bowl after bed! We are Puget Sound chowder heads!

Song ends with Dave, Kerri and John laughing and hugging each other as they continue walking on Puget Sound.

INT. DAVE, KERRI WITH JOHN IN HIS OFFICE

John, Kerri, and Dave are back in John's office at Capital Forestry in Roslyn, Washington.

KERRI (sadly) So this is it? Our last day.

DAVE It is not going to be easy to say goodbye to you two!

JOHN (very serious) I've got something to tell you both. I didn't want to say anything during our trip to Puget Sound.

KERRI (sensing it is serious) John?..what is it?

JOHN I've been diagnosed with brain cancer,..it doesn't look good,..

DAVE (very upset shouting) No friggin' way! No!!

JOHN Yeah, it's true Dave, .. I knew something wasn't right a couple months ago. Strange headaches and even some blacking out. KERRI (remembering) So that's when you were out those 2 weeks,..? JOHN Yeah my wife took me to Seattle for a dozen or so tests. Came back the same,.. DAVE (rushes out of the office) Son-of-a-fuckin' bitch,.. KERRI (calling after Dave) Dave! JOHN Let him go Kerri,.. KERRI (crying) Dave loves you so much John, ... you trusted him with your life's research! You had faith that he was the right man for the job. JOHN Yeah I'll go talk to him,.. John follows Dave outside. Dave runs into the nearby woods and breaks down in tears. John comes to console him. JOHN (CONT'D) (with a smile patting Dave on the back) Hey Dave, ... I'm the one with the fucked-up brain,.. DAVE (crying) Damn it John, ... you believed in me

and trusted me to help manage your work! Now the goddamn lands are sold off,.. (MORE) DAVE (CONT'D) we'll lose it all!..and, to top it off I'm losing my mentor,..and my best friend!

JOHN But Dave,..it's been all worth it hasn't it? You, and so many others have helped me,..helped us build new forests,..

Kerri joins John and Dave as all the foresters, tree planters, mill workers, and Capital Forestry employees come together as John sings the song <u>Forest Builders</u>.

EXT. JOHN MASTERS, KERRI, DAVE AND ALL SING

JOHN MASTERS

[verse 1] Times they change, so some say, We became friends, but how fast the time has slipped away, And we, forest builders, the woods our common bond, We go on,..we go on.

[interlude]
Up a dusty road, down thru a muddy slough,
Yes it's true the trees fall hard,
But nature helps us build anew!

[verse 2] Lessons we have learned, thru the fires, and the droughts,

Yet, there wouldn't be a forest without us!

JOHN, KERRI, DAVE AND ALL [chorus] And the sun, shines down on the leaves of the trees, That we planted, and nourished in the rain. As the wind, blows softly thru the fir, and pine, The memories, of our forests will remain!

[organ full ranks solo]

JOHN MASTERS [verse 3] There's no reason for despair, We've been so lucky, to have this time to share, And we, forest builders, can hold our heads up high, We'll go on,..we'll go on.

JOHN, KERRI, DAVE AND ALL [chorus] And the sun, shines down on the leaves of the trees, That we planted, and nourished in the rain. As the wind, blows softly thru the fir, and pine, The memories, of our forests will remain!

JOHN, KERRI, DAVE [tag ending] And the sun, shines down on the leaves of our trees,

Dave and Kerri wrap arms around each other, with tears in their eyes. They walk with all the foresters, tree planters, mill workers, and other employees and slowly disappear into the woods beyond.

John is left alone to sing the final stanza.

JOHN

The trees,...the trees,...

John disappears into the woods, .. and into heaven, ..

FADE OUT.

EXT. AT JOHN'S FUNERAL - KERRI AND DAVE SAY GOODBYE.

MOURNERS ARE COMING OUT OF A CHURCH where services have just been held for John Masters who has succumbed to brain cancer.

Dave and Kerri walk out of the church arm-in-arm. Kerri is crying. Dave has a stern look on his face. They walk over to a park and sit down on a bench to talk.

Dave and Kerri kiss, then Dave holds her hand.

DAVE (somber) Kerri,..I've decided to head back to Minnesota,.. KERRI (upset) Oh no Dave,.. DAVE (determined) Kerri,..we've had a wonderful,..I guess, affair? I've loved the time we have spent together, especially the trip to Puget Sound with John,...but now, with so much lost, .. Minnesota is calling me back. I love that place, and I want to go back to the home I built. KERRI (tears coming) I know Dave, .. I guess I knew from the start we couldn't share anything permanent. DAVE You've still got a husband, ...maybe now you'll have time to work that all out? KERRI (accepting) Yes, I do owe him that. It should work,...somehow,...but I also know you have to go back to Minnesota to find that 'missing woman' in your life.

DAVE Yes Kerri,..I do believe she is there,..somewhere,..

Kerri hugs Dave, holding on for a minute.

KERRI (full tears now as she backs away) Go on Dave Wagner,..go re-connect with your beloved Minnesota! (sadly)
Goodbye Kerri,..I'll never forget
you,..who knows,..maybe some day in
a few years I might return to
Washington,..and to Puget Sound?

KERRI If you ever do come back Dave Wagner,..

Dave and Kerri share a final kiss. Dave climbs into his van. Kerri waves a last goodbye as Dave drives off.

EXT. DAVE RETURNS TO MINNESOTA - NOVEMBER 1982

IT IS EARLY NOVEMBER and cold, as Dave drives up the road to his Minnesota home. There is a light dusting of snow on the ground. It is dusk as the sun is setting.

Dave is overcome with excitement at seeing his house and land again. Dave stops the van at his drive entrance, then jumps out of and runs to his house as he sings and dances to the song <u>Minnesota</u>. As Dave sings the song the northern lights begin to appear in the early evening sky.

DAVE

[verse 1] There's a land, far away, That I saw, one day, Minnesota.

[verse 2]
Yes, I longed for in my heart,
To build my life in just one part,

in Minnesota.

[verse 4] Well I've turned my life around, Got my feet back on the ground, of Minnesota!

[chorus]

[verse 5]
Yes it seemed so right,

INT./EXT. WAKING UP AS THE MOON SETS - JANUARY 1983

A FRIGID MINNESOTA MORNING. A WOOD STOVE IS CRACKLING. Dave is standing inside his house looking out a window as the moon sets in the West. THE SUN RISES VERY LOW ON THE EASTERN HORIZON.

A HAUNTING FRENCH HORN SOLO.

CHOREOGRAPHY: Dave runs outside and breaks into a powerful dance as he sings the final song <u>Waking Up As The Moon Sets</u>.

SONG 17: WAKING UP AS THE MOON SETS (6:02) http://pugetsoundmusical.com/minnesota/moonsets.mp3

DAVE

[verse 1]
Waking up as the moon sets,
My day, just begins,
Oh this land, is so quiet,
And so cold.

[verse 2]
